The Department of Radiology and Medical Imaging organized an international workshop on Neurosonology on May 27, 2024, at Saleem Campus. The event brought together renowned experts in the field, where esteemed guest speakers Prof Dr Med Fabienne Perren (MD, PhD), University of Geneva, President NSRG, World Federation of Neurosonology Switzerland and Prof Dr Syed Amir Gilani, Rector, TUF shared their theoretical and practical experience with participants. The workshop aimed to enhance knowledge and skills in neurosonology, promoting better patient care and using ultrasonography to evaluate cerebral circulation and the nervous system, enabling non-invasive assessment of blood flow in intracranial and

extracranial vessels. Chief guest speaker, Prof Dr Med Fabienne Perren focused on exploring the innovative intersection of ultrasound technology and neuroscience, delving deep into the realm of brain imaging and vascular dynamics. Through the detailed presentation on cutting-edge research and clinical practices in Neurosonology, participants acquired hands-on experience with state-of-the-art neurosonography equipment under the guidance of international experts. Prof Dr Syed Amir Gilani started his presentation with an overview of Ultrasound for Peripheral Nerves, evaluation of peripheral nerves, and sonography of peripheral nerves. His presentation covered a pictorial comparison

of normal and compressed nerves, an insight into proximal nerve swelling, main groups of nerve entrapment, and the axial oblique plane. The workshop attracted a diverse group of participants and students from the fields of radiology, neurology, sonography and allied health science. The event featured a series of interactive sessions which provided a unique opportunity for networking, knowledge exchange, and fostering collaborations across disciplines and institutions. The discussion session allowed participants to delve deeper into specific topics and share their own experiences and challenges. 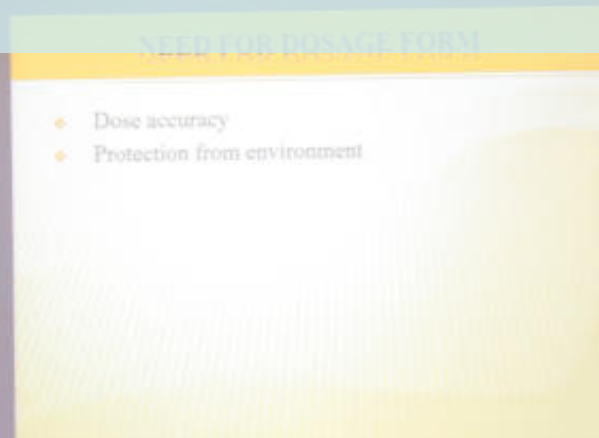

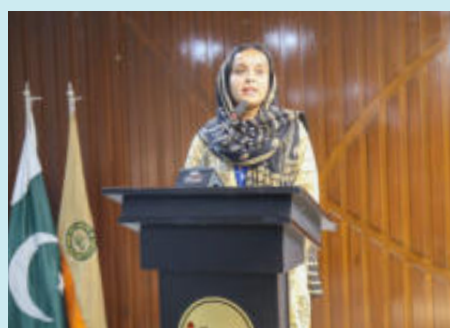

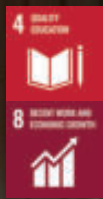


## LECTURE ON "Presentation and Appearance in Interview"

Several factors contribute to this rise; notably, vaping products are frequently marketed with appealing flavors such as fruit, candy, and dessert, which are particularly attractive to younger users. Additionally, social circles and peer pressure significantly influence the adoption of vaping. A common belief among many young people is that vaping is a safer alternative to smoking traditional cigarettes. To address and spread awareness about these misconceptions, the Department of Community Medicine, UMDC in collaboration with PINUM Cancer Hospital Faisalabad and the Drug and Tobacco Awareness Society at The University of Faisalabad, has initiated targeted educational campaigns. Prof Dr Aamir Ali Choudhary, Dean, Faculty of Sciences, Prof Dr Shirza Nadeem, the Vice-Principal UMDC, and Prof Dr Saba Tariq, Dean Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, honored the seminar with their

presence and commended the contributions of the fourth-year MBBS students. During the seminar, Dr Rana Qamar Javed, a Consultant Medical Oncologist at PINUM Cancer Hospital, emphasized that extensive medical research has conclusively established that carcinogens in

tobacco are responsible for more than twelve types of cancer. He further noted that the majority of patients at PINUM Cancer Hospital are diagnosed at stage 3 or stage 4, stages at which only palliative treatment is available, offering merely symptomatic relief. Dr Javed also highlighted



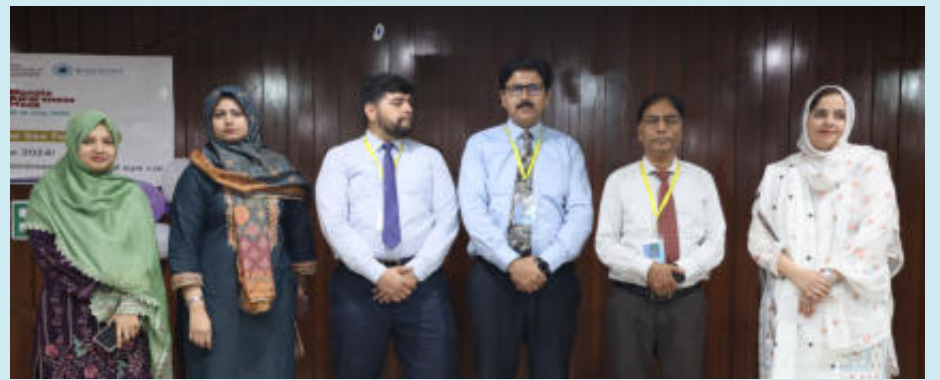
that studies indicate a direct correlation between the risk of cancer and both the number of cigarettes smoked per day and the duration of chronic smoking. Dr Javed underscored the importance of dispelling the misconception among youth that modern methods of smoking, such as e-cigarettes and vapes, are harmless. In reality, the chemicals present in these devices can be more harmful than those in traditional cigarettes. 4th Year MBBS students actively participated in the seminar, delivering presentations on three key topics: the evolution of the tobacco industry from sponsorship to the banning of tobacco, trends in sheesha smoking among females in Pakistan, and a comprehensive dialogue between two fourth-year MBBS students discussing the effects of vaping, including its pros and cons. Ms Ifra Irfan, General Secretary of the Drug & Tobacco Awareness Society, addressed the audience, outlining the efforts undertaken by their organization to raise awareness among students and youth about the dangers of drugs, vaping, and e-cigarettes. The society members also distributed informational flyers to the audience to further disseminate this critical information.

### Addressing Uncorrected Refractive Errors: MYOPIA Awareness Week Screening Initiative

In observance of Myopia Awareness Week, on May 13, 2024, eighth-semester students from the Department of Optometry, alongside their faculty members, set out on an important initiative to the Government Islamic and Modern Education School System. Led by Dr Nimra Gul and Dr Syeda Khadija Fatima, their objective was to conduct a comprehensive screening for uncorrected refractive errors among schoolchildren. Upon arrival, they were warmly received by the principal and staff of the school, where the principal

provided valuable insights into the school's environment. The screening camp was meticulously planned to detect undiagnosed refractive errors, a common yet often overlooked issue affecting children's vision. The screening protocols implemented were thorough and encompassed various assessments, including history taking to understand any existing eye-related symptoms, torchlight examination to check for external abnormalities, visual acuity testing to assess the clarity of vision, ophthalmoscopy to examine the interior structures



of the eye, retinoscopy to determine the refractive error, refraction to prescribe corrective lenses if needed, and medication assessment to identify any ocular conditions requiring treatment. The team's dedication ensured that each student underwent a comprehensive examination to identify uncorrected refractive errors promptly. Out of the over 300 students screened, nearly 100 were diagnosed with myopia, highlighting the prevalence of uncorrected refractive errors among school-aged children. By addressing these issues through early detection and intervention, the screening camp not only contributed to enhancing the visual health of the students but also underscored the importance of regular eye examinations in ensuring optimal vision and academic performance.

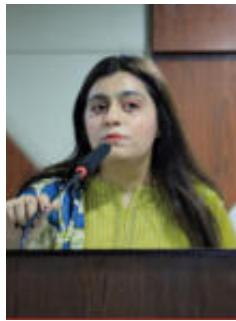


## ADR's Inaugural Event: A Milestone in Promoting Sustainable Peace and Justice

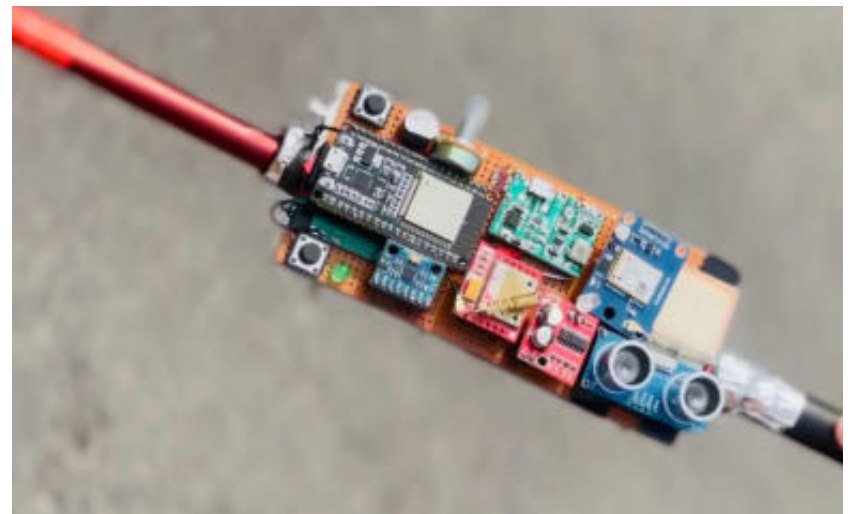

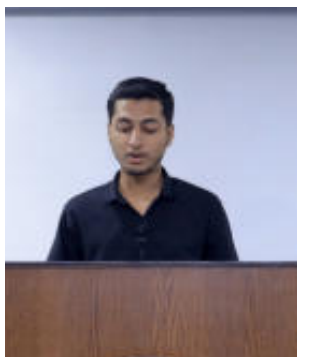
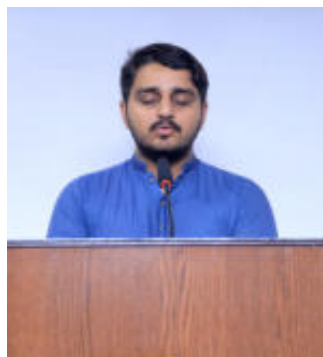
