TUF Holds 11th Convocation with 1796 Graduates Honored

Governor Punjab/ Patron of the University, H.E Sardar Saleem Haider Khan presided over the 11th Convocation of The University of Faisalabad on 2, December 2024. The ceremony was attended by Mian Muhammad Hanif, Chairman Madinah Foundation, Mian Muhammad Haider Amin, Chairman Board of Governors, Mian Khalid Riaz and Mr Hassan Rasheed, Members Board of Governors, Prof Dr Amanullah Malik, Rector, TUF, Prof Dr Syed Amir Gilani, Rector, Green International University, Dr Zahida Maqbool, Registrar, TUF, Deans, departments' heads, faculty members, graduates, and their parents.

At the beginning of the ceremony, to show solidarity with the oppressed people of Palestine, students of TUF recited a special poem, joined by Palestinian students currently studying at the university.

A total of 1796 graduates received their degrees at the convocation, including 17 PhDs. Graduates hailed from faculties including Medicine and Allied Health Sciences, Pharmaceutical Sciences, Science, Information Technology, Management Studies, Engineering & Technology, and Arts & Social Sciences. Graduates took an oath to remain committed to their fields and fulfill their responsibilities with dedication.

Outstanding students in various disciplines were awarded medals, with 20 receiving Saleem Gold Medals, 47 receiving Mukhtar Silver Medals, and 20 receiving Amin Bronze Medals. Governor Punjab distributed medals and certificates among the high-achieving graduates.

In his address, H.E Sardar Saleem Haider Khan congratulated all the graduates, their parents, and faculty members. He commended the graduates for making their parents proud and acknowledged the sacrifices their families made to ensure their education. He emphasized that while their academic journey had ended, their real responsibilities were just beginning as they stepped into professional life. TUF Achieves Global Recognition in UI GreenMetric Rankings: 356th Globally, 11th Overall, 6th Among Private Universities

The University of Faisalabad has achieved a remarkable milestone by securing a spot in the prestigious Top 500 universities globally in the UI GreenMetric World University Rankings. Ranked 356th globally, TUF has demonstrated its commitment to sustainability, reinforcing its role as a leader in promoting eco-friendly practices and green initiatives across the campus. In addition to its outstanding global ranking, TUF has also excelled within Pakistan, ranking 11th overall and 6th among private universities. This achievement highlights the university's dedication to integrating sustainability into its operations, academic offerings, and community engagement efforts.

The UI GreenMetric Rankings assess universities worldwide based on their commitment to environmental sustainability, looking at factors such as energy usage, waste management, water conservation, and green building initiatives. TUF's success in these rankings is a testament to the university's long-standing commitment to creating an environment that fosters both academic excellence and environmental stewardship.

Road Safety Awareness Seminar at TUF, Empowers Women for Safer Roads

The University of Faisalabad, in collaboration with the National Highways and Motorway Police (NHMP), organized an impactful session titled “Women's Role in Road Safety” on December 17, 2024. The event underscored women's significant contribution to promoting road safety awareness and advancing responsible driving practices across society. The session featured Mr Dar Ali Khan Khattak, PSP, DIG MOTORWAY C-II-ZONE as the Chief Guest, who provided a detailed overview of global and local road safety statistics. Other notable participants included Mr Qalab Abbas Sipra, Superintendent NHMP, Mr Rana Irfan Ahmed, Road Safety Officer, Ms Samina Sarwat, Deputy Superintendent of Police, and other team members. The event was attended by, Prof Dr Aman Ullah Malik, Rector, TUF, Dr Zahida Maqbool, Registrar, TUF, faculty members, and a large number of students. In his opening remarks, Mr Dar Ali Khan emphasized: “Women are pivotal in promoting road safety. By equipping them with driving skills, road knowledge, and access to safe infrastructure, we can reduce road accidents and ensure safer mobility for everyone. Women's participation will lead to a safer, more inclusive transportation system.”

He revealed that road traffic accidents are one of the leading causes of fatalities worldwide, disproportionately affecting developing countries, including Pakistan. Highlighting startling facts, it was revealed that 1.19 million deaths and 20-50 million injuries occur annually worldwide due to road accidents, with developing countries contributing to 92% of these fatalities. Pakistan, alarmingly ranked first in Asia for road accident deaths in 2022, loses billions in economic costs annually due to traffic mishaps.

The presentation emphasized the 3Es of Road Safety—Engineering, Education, and Enforcement—as vital components to mitigate accidents. Participants learned about essential road safety principles, including vehicle inspection procedures (FLOWER method), proper steering techniques, speed management, and critical traffic rules.

Prof Dr Amanullah Malik, in his vote of thanks, expressed gratitude to the chief guest, Mr Dar Ali Khan Khattak, the NHMP team, and all participants for their valuable contributions to the seminar. He emphasized the importance of collective efforts in spreading road safety awareness and urged everyone to implement the insights shared during the session in their daily lives. He specifically highlighted the pivotal role of women in road safety, noting that their involvement in advocating for safer driving practices is crucial in creating lasting change within families, communities, and society at large.

In addition to the session, the NHMP team set up informative stalls featuring road safety materials and literature to engage attendees. These stalls provided valuable resources, including pamphlets, guides, and safety tips, ensuring that participants could take home practical knowledge to further spread road safety awareness. The event was a resounding success, effectively promoting road safety awareness and empowering participants to become responsible road users. As the NHMP aptly concluded, “The life you save can be your own.”

Pop *Sculpture* Workshop Subtractive Carving

A hands-on workshop focused on Plaster of Paris (POP) Sculpture was conducted for Bachelor of Interior Design students from the Department of Design and Interiors on December 11, 2024. The workshop was supervised by Ms Nouma Irfan and Ms Jaweria Shabir.

The primary objective of this workshop was to introduce students to the art of sculpting using Plaster of Paris, enabling them to develop creative expressions through three-dimensional forms. Students explored various sculptural techniques, textures, and forms to create aesthetically appealing and structurally sound pieces.



The workshop was divided into structured steps to enhance learning and artistic exploration:

Creative Exploration and Skill Development: The workshop aimed to encourage students to think creatively, experiment with sculpting techniques, and develop skills in molding, carving, and finishing POP structures.

Understanding Form and Texture: Students focused on exploring different forms inspired by architectural, cultural, and natural elements. They experimented with textures and detailing to create visually engaging sculptures, learning to balance artistic creativity with structural integrity.

Material and Technique Integration: The workshop emphasized combining traditional sculpting methods with modern design principles. Students utilized carving tools, molds, and finishing techniques to create sculptures that highlighted surface patterns, depth, and shadows.

Conceptual Development and Execution: Each student worked individually, developing concepts through brainstorming, sketching, and inspiration boards. They designed sculptures that reflected their chosen themes, focusing on integrating artistic expression with functionality. Students created sculptures inspired by various concepts, including architectural forms, organic shapes, and geometric patterns. Their designs emphasized creativity, balance, and attention to detail, showcasing both artistic and technical skills.

This workshop successfully combined artistic exploration with technical expertise. It provided students with an opportunity to apply their creativity and craftsmanship while gaining hands-on experience in working with Plaster of Paris. The sculptures produced reflected thoughtful conceptual development and meticulous execution, enhancing the students' understanding of form, texture, and material manipulation.



Students from the Department of Design & Interior Explore Innovation and Art at **IAPEX'24** and Lahore Biennale

Department of Design and Interior's study tour to IAPEX'24 at the Expo Centre Lahore and the Lahore Biennale at the Alhamra Art Council offered a rich learning experience for students of interior and graphic design, expanding their knowledge through exposure to both industry innovations and contemporary art.

At IAPEX'24, the students explored a wide array of exhibits that showcased the latest in architectural materials, furniture design, and sustainable building solutions. Students were particularly fascinated by the innovative use of materials, such as eco-friendly wood alternatives and composite furniture options. Interior design students gained insights into integrating sustainability with aesthetics, while graphic design students observed how visual branding influences spatial layout and the user experience, learning to appreciate the blend of practicality and design in professional settings.

The next visit to the Lahore Biennale at Alhamra Art Council immersed students in the world of contemporary art, presenting a stark contrast to the commercial focus of IAPEX'24. They were introduced to diverse art forms, from multimedia installations to conceptual sculptures, which encouraged them to think critically about art as a means of social and cultural commentary. A highlight of this visit was meeting Turkish art director Köken Ergün, who engaged with the students and explained the underlying themes in his work, often centered around identity, community, and cultural expression. His discussion inspired students to see contemporary art as more than aesthetic expression, but as a tool for storytelling and dialogue. Additionally, we had the honor of viewing a short film by acclaimed artist Sin Wai Kin. The film captivated students with its exploration of identity and fluidity, demonstrating how moving images can evoke complex emotions and themes. This exposure provided students with a new perspective on storytelling techniques in visual media, particularly relevant for graphic design students in their narrative-driven projects.

Participants were divided into groups and encouraged to create individual or collaborative clay pieces. The students explored various themes, such as abstract forms, functional objects, and miniature sculptures. At the end of the session, constructive feedback was provided on the students' work, emphasizing areas of strength and suggesting improvements. Students were also encouraged to share their creative processes and challenges. The clay workshop was a resounding success, achieving its objectives of skill development, creativity enhancement, and inter-semester collaboration.

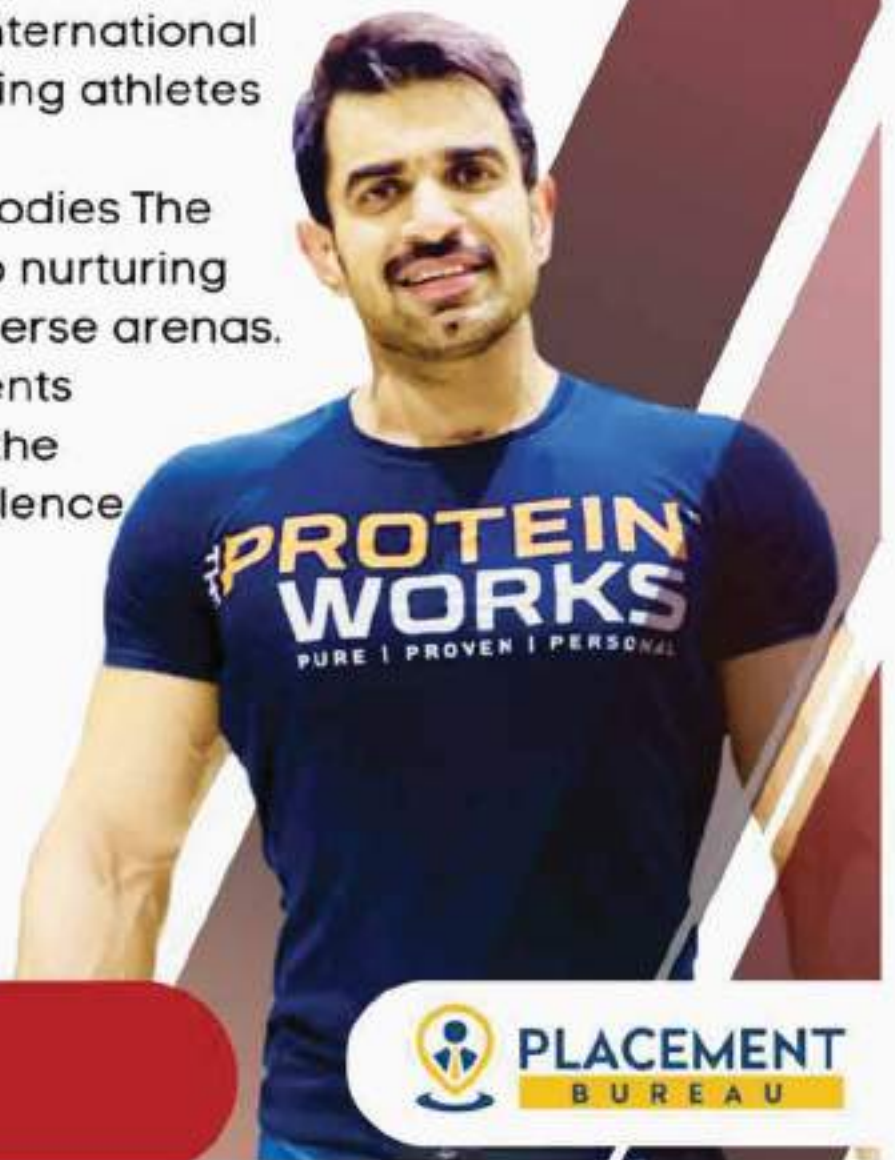

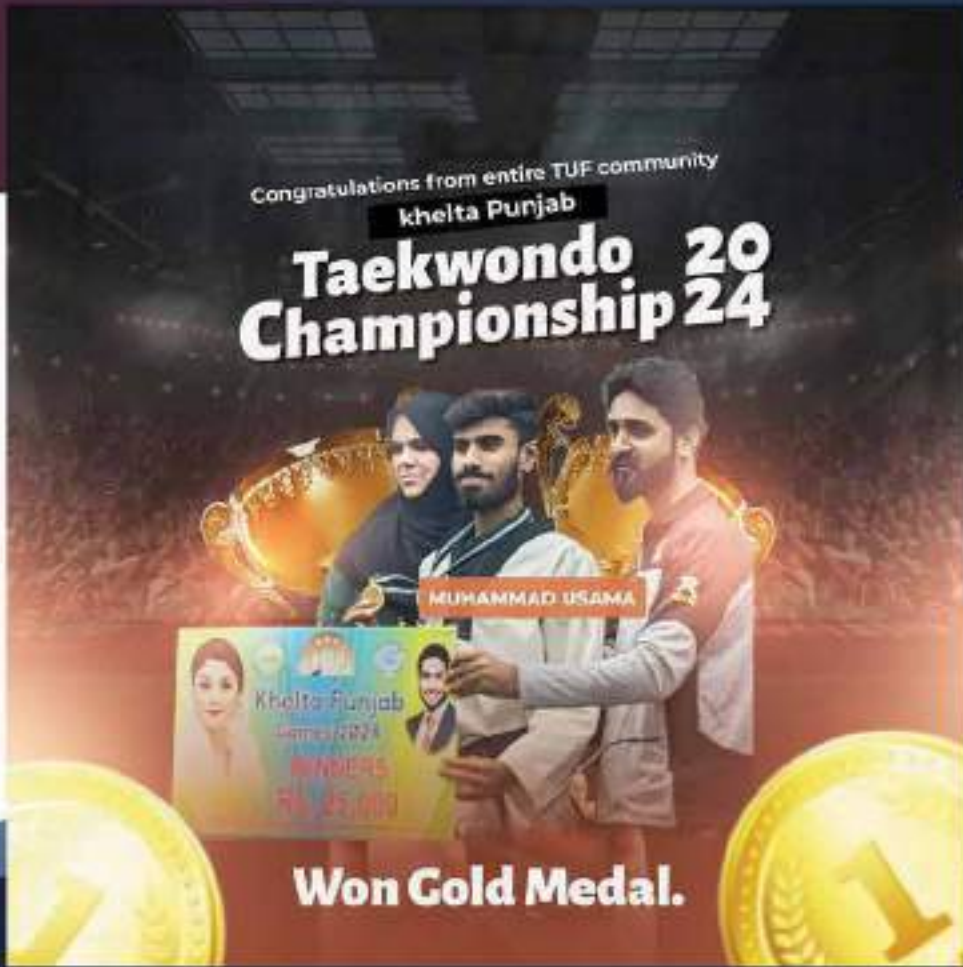
Beyond the podium, Nawaz is a Level 3 International Certified Fitness Trainer, mentoring aspiring athletes and fitness enthusiasts.

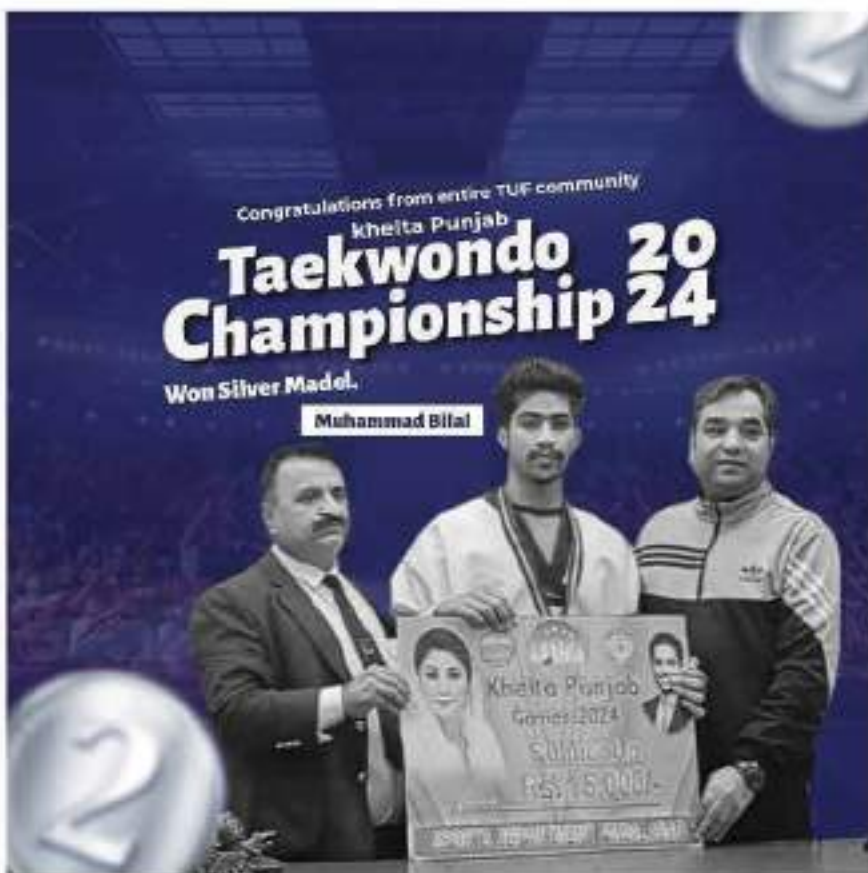

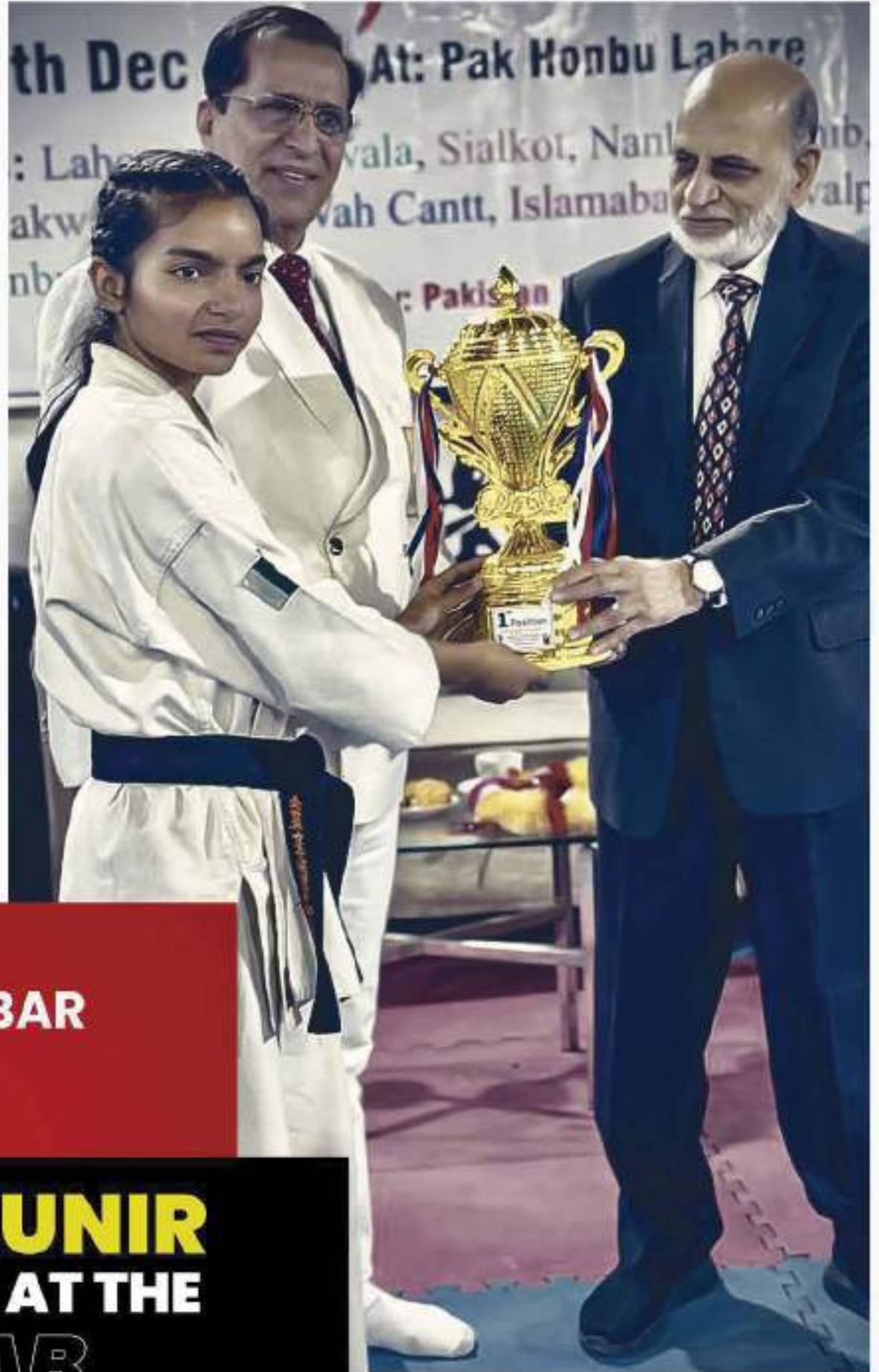
Mujtaba Ghanni, a Biotechnology student from TUF, outplayed his opponent from the University of Sargodha, securing the win.
