Seminar on “Breast cancer management & its prevention”

The University of Faisalabad organized an international seminar on “Breast cancer management & its prevention” on 18th June.

The guest speaker Professor Dr Abdul Basit, an eminent consultant breast surgeon at Stafford General Hospital affiliated with Keele University UK, addressing the audience expressed that word cancer is nightmare for anyone. Breast cancer is top of the list among the cancers in females. In Pakistan its incidence has exponentially increased. Young age females are affected by this dreadful disease. Estrogen play key role in the causation of breast cancer. Breast feeding has protective role against breast cancer. However females having children are less likely to get breast cancer compared to one with no child.

He attributed the high frequency of breast cancer to different type of grilled and junk food which ultimately produces estrogens. He suggested avoiding these foods and switching to simple homemade foods especially vegetables may work well.

He highly appreciated the Madinah foundation on

commendable job in connection with such programs and civic engagements. He urged that every teaching hospital must have a breast cancer screening clinics with proper data maintenance and referral system in place. Talking on this occasion Pro Rector, TUF Professor Dr Mohammad Iqbal Tahir, urged that females education can play pivotal role in addressing economic and health issues like breast cancer. Educated female can recognize disease earlier than illiterate. On the occasion Dr Zahid Masood, Head Department of Community Medicine added that Primary Health Care System must be strengthened to reduce load on teaching hospitals. Further, diseases of public health importance should be made part of primary and secondary school curriculum. Education should not be left to choice of parents. Professor of Surgery Dr Sajid Sheikh also spoke on the occasion. He disclosed that patient lands too late in teaching hospitals when cancer is spread to different body parts. Dr Saeed Akhtar, a nuclear Physician, Dr Mubashara Naz Assistant Professor of Gynecologist and Dr Khalid Mehmood Yahya Associate Professor of Medicine, Madinah Teaching Hospital also spoke on the occasion. In the end, Professor Mohammad Iqbal Tahir presented a memento to Professor Basit. After the seminar Dr Basit visited Madinah Teaching Hospital and highly appreciated the dedicated faculty and facilities provided especially free food and free treatment.

Seminar on “Road Safety Awareness”

Every day around the world, more than 3000 people die from road traffic injury. In Pakistan every year more than 10,000 people die due to road traffic accidents. This was disclosed in a seminar organized by The University of Faisalabad and National Highways & Motor way Police (NHMP) on May 23, 2014

Dr Zahid Masood Head Department of Community Health Sciences TUF in his address said that low-income and middle-income countries account for about 85% of the deaths. Without appropriate action, by 2020, road traffic injuries are predicted to be the third leading contributor to the global burden of disease and injury.

Road traffic accidents were on increase in Faisalabad city and common causes included carelessness and over speeding. Motorcyclists were most affected and people in age group from 20 to 29 years were worst affected by RTA. Prevention was superior to rehabilitation and treatment in case of RTAs, Dr Masood added. On the occasion Dr Sumera Shahzad also spoke on the prevention of road traffic accidents. Mobile education unit of NHMP passed on very valuable information on road safety. Senior Patrolling Officer NHMP police Rana Muhammad Irfan in his deliberation focused on the importance of observing road rules. He informed that over 60 percents deaths

could be prevented by use of seat belts and airbag. He showed very informative videos on road safety. Prof Dr Faqir Hussain Dean Faculty of Health Sciences TUF highly

appreciated the services on NHMP and the deliberation by Rana Irfan. He urged that nations are recognized by road disciplines and we must observe road rules.

Seminar on "World Malaria Day"

A seminar was organized in The University of Faisalabad to mark the world malaria day on April 25, 2014. Professor Dr Faqir Hussain Dean Faculty of Health Sciences was the chief guest. Dr Zahid Masood, Head Department of Community Health Sciences in his key note address unveiled some hard facts about malaria. He said that still malaria was one of major cause of morbidity in Pakistan and due to the disease, sizeable number of patients become economically inactive for months. According to recent estimates of

WHO, 98% Pakistani population was living in malaria transmission zone. Dr Masood said that people living in the poorest countries are the most vulnerable. Moreover, women are 4 times more likely to suffer malaria attacks during pregnancy resulting in low weight babies and stillbirths. World Malaria Day was an occasion to highlight the need for continued investment and sustained political commitment to control and eliminate this deadly disease, Dr Masood added. He suggested that all the major outbreaks & common diseases

along with cause and prevention be made part of curriculum at school and college level in Pakistan. Professor Dr Faqir Hussain said that more research should be carried out to address the issue of vector borne diseases especially Malaria and Dengue. He also stressed on judicious use of anti malarial drugs to overcome the problem of drug resistance. Dr Sumera Shehzad and Ms Afsheen also spoke on the theme of Malaria day. Seminar was followed by an awareness walk.

Seminar on “World No Tobacco Day”

The tobacco epidemic is one of the biggest public health threats the world has ever faced, killing nearly six million people a year. If unchecked, toll will go up to 8 million by 2030. This was disclosed in a seminar held in The University of Faisalabad. There were 30 million tobacco smokers in Pakistan and 80,000 people died annually because of it. The number of girl smokers in the country has jumped from 6 percent to 22 percent in recent years said Dr Zahid Masood, Head Department of Community Health Sciences, TUF in seminar to mark the World No Tobacco day. Over 20 percent of females in different educational institutions of Pakistan smoke sheesha, Dr Masood added. Pakistanis consume Rs 450 billion worth of tobacco annually. Referring to WHO studies Dr Masood said that approximately one person dies every six seconds due to tobacco.

A tax increase that increases tobacco prices by 10 percent, decreases tobacco consumption by about 8 percent in low- and middle-income countries like Pakistan WHO recommends. Hard-hitting anti-tobacco advertisements and graphic pack warnings – especially those that

include pictures – reduce the number of children who begin smoking. Mass media campaigns can also reduce tobacco consumption, he added. Prof Dr Faqir Hussain Khan Dean Faculty of Health Sciences and Chief Guest of the occasion showed deep concern on increasing health hazards of tobacco and premature deaths due to second hand smoking. He endorsed the theme of increasing tax on tobacco and enforcement of WHO Framework Convention on Tobacco Control. Earlier on Dr Shama and Ms Maham of 4th year MBBS spoke about the theme of day.

Department of Surgery, University Medical & Dental College, organized a seminar on "World Brain Tumor Day" in auditorium of Madinah Teaching Hospital.

Guest speaker, Dr Akmal Hussain, Neuro Surgeon, Allied Hospital, in his key note address said that brain tumour is an abnormal mass of tissue in which some cells grow and multiply uncontrollably, apparently unregulated by the mechanisms that

control normal cells. The growth of a tumour takes up space within the skull and interferes with normal brain activity. Tumor can cause damage by increasing pressure in the brain. He further explained that according to

medical experts mostly people above 35 years of age suffer from it and usually after struggling for a period of five years one-third patients die. Dr Irshad Ahmed thanked the guests and audience.
