CME Session on "Laboratory Diagnosis of Chronic Hepatitis C and Cancer Registration"

A Continued Medical Education (CME) activity titled; "Laboratory Diagnosis of Chronic Hepatitis C and Population Based Cancer Registration" was held on May 20, 2017. The event was conducted by the Department of Pathology, UMDC in collaboration with Shaukat Khanum Memorial Cancer Hospital & Research Center Lahore.

A large number of medical graduates and healthcare providers from the renowned institutes of city attended the event. Dr Farhana Badar, Senior Biostatistician & Cancer Epidemiologist; Shaukat Khanum Memorial Cancer Hospital & Research Center presented an overview of the cancer situation in Pakistan, especially in Punjab. She also introduced various methodologies available and types of

cancer registries. An important content of her knowledgeable presentation was the proforma to get enrolled as a member of cancer registry program and another perform for the patient registry.

The second guest speaker Dr Imran S Chaudhry while delivering lecture on "Laboratory Diagnosis of Viral Hepatitis" emphasized the confirmation of infection in specific situations during the disease course along with false positive and false negative cases. When the treatment must be started and what appropriate

WORLD NO TOBACCO DAY

A Threat to Development

Tobacco is responsible for approx 80,000 deaths annually in Pakistan directly or indirectly. It was major cause of lung cancer and heart diseases globally in addition to many other diseases attributed to smoking. This was disclosed by Prof Dr Zahid Masood in a seminar to mark the "No tobacco day" on May 31, 2017.

Dr Zahid Masood, Head Department of Community Medicine, UMDc said that according to State Bank report Pakistanis spent Rs 250 billion on over 64 billion

cigarettes in the financial year 2014. The number of young female smokers in Pakistan had jumped to 16.3% from 6% in recent years. According to a study conducted in Pakistan frequency of shisha smoking among students was 19.7%. Smoking Shisha for an hour was equivalent to smoking 100 cigarettes in the same time. Speaking on the occasion, guest speaker, Dr Rafshan Sadiq, Head Department of Oncology at PINUM, Faisalabad threw light on the harmful effects of smoking on fetus during

pregnancy. Chief Guest of the seminar, Prof Dr Muhammad Saeed, Dean Faculty of Medicine and Allied Health Sciences, TUF said that there was dire need to educate people on harmful effects of smoking on individuals and their families. He appreciated the efforts of Government of Punjab to address the menace of shisha smoking. Earlier, Prof Dr Abdul Haq Director ORIC expressed his views. Dr Uzma Sagheer gave the overview and spoke on the theme of No tobacco day.

including musculoskeletal assessment, diagnosis and treatment plan. During the event students distributed brochures with ergonomic counseling and exercise plans.

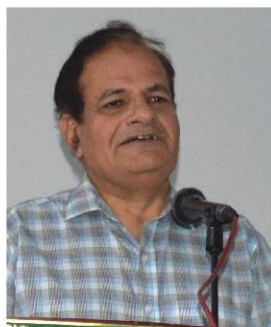

World Sight Day, observed annually on the second Thursday of October, is a global event meant to draw attention on blindness and vision impairment. To mark the day, students of Doctor of Optometry, 9th semester organized School Children Eye Screening camp in University Cambridge School, Sargodha Road, Faisalabad on October 17, 2017.

Screening was based on anterior eye examination, refractive errors, squint and BSV assessment. Total number of 130 students were evaluated from class 1 to 8. Both genders were screened for ocular examination and visual acuity. The main outcomes of this program were found as refractive errors in 43 students, strabismus in 5 children and allergic eye conditions in

25 students. Also 36 students had 6/6 vision. The major factor was of decrease of vision upon testing through VA Snellen chart. After refractive errors strabismus was second most common finding. Allergies of eye were also found. Teachers were counseled about students' conditions and how to manage them.

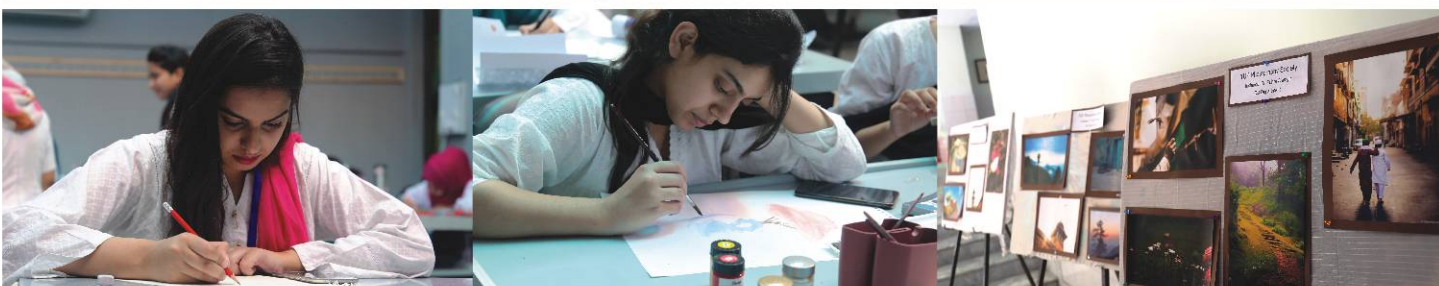

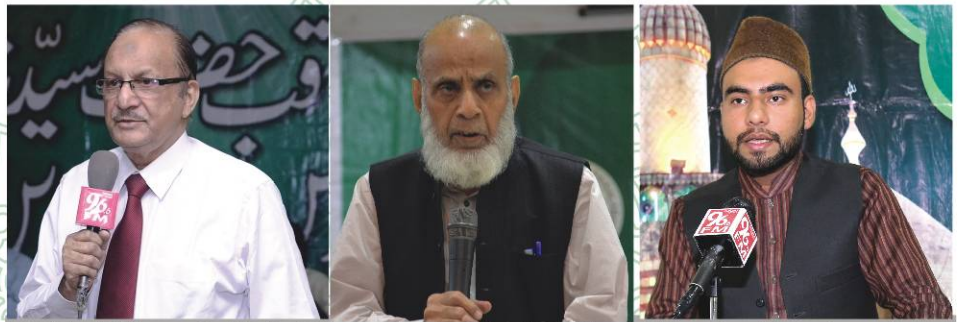
Quiz Competition “Yom-e-Shahadat Hazrat Ali Kararam Allah Wajhahu”

Bone Strength and BMI screening camp

Osteoporosis and osteopenia is widely prevalent in Pakistan. This leads to formation of porous and fragile bones vulnerable to fractures especially in old age.

Department of Community Medicine and School of Nutrition & Dietetics organized a screening camp in Health Sciences Campus on May 4, 2017.

Prof Dr Zahid Masood, HoD, Community Medicine supervised the activity aimed to screen the bone strength by testing T-Score. In addition to that Vitamin D estimation was done using indirect method by asking questions about dietary habits. Moreover, test for Body Mass Index (BMI) was also done. Large number of students, faculty members and staff was screened out. This offered a useful learning curve to MBBS and DND students.

Screening of Refractive Errors by School of Optometry

According to WHO, leading causes of blindness in children are uncorrected refractive error, amblyopia and strabismus. Knowing its significance, School of Optometry arranged a one day study tour for screening of refractive errors in the students of Government High School Satellite Town Chiniot on September 16, 2017. All students of OD 5th semester alongwith their faculty members visited the school and conducted activities to screen out refractive error and symptomless eye condition. Two hundred students from primary to secondary level were screened out from general stream lined classes and were guided about their refractive status and effects on their eyes.

Multiple vision screening tests were performed like, visual acuity, color vision, convergence insufficiency, EOM, anterior eye examination, Hirschberg test (corneal reflex test), pupil reflex and visual field by confrontation method.

Out of 200 students 150 students were evaluated with decreased vision and multiple ocular and vision problems and remaining 50 students were normal.

MTH laboratory was amongst the best labs declared by Punjab Health Care Commission. Now it has been claimed to be one best among the international laboratories around the world.

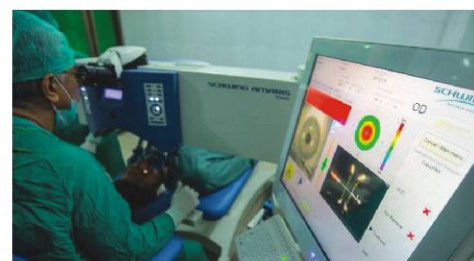


Latest Excimer Laser installed in MTH

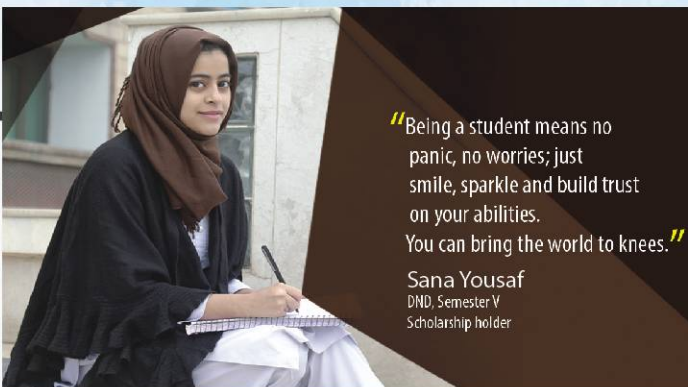
