World Environment Day is the United Nations' most important day for encouraging worldwide awareness and action for the protection of our environment. On 5th June, Pakistan is hosting World Environment Day

2021 on the theme of 'Ecosystem Restoration' and focus on resetting our relation with nature in partnership with the UN Environment Programme. Pakistan is among the six countries that face the biggest impact from

climate change, according to the United Nations, with risks of floods, melting glaciers and droughts. Its forest cover is now among the lowest in the world, about 5% of the land, compared with a global average of

31%, according to UN's Food and Agriculture Organization. In one of the world's most ambitious afforestation efforts, Pakistan plans to expand and restore forests across the country through a drive it calls the 10

Billion Tree Tsunami. The campaign includes restoring mangroves and other forests, as well as planting trees in urban settings, including schools, colleges, public parks and green belts.

TUFIANS SHOW WAYS TO 'ECOSYSTEM RESTORATION' ON WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY

The University of Faisalabad (TUF) has purpose built Campus provides comfortable and conducive academic environment in serene, safe and healthy surroundings. As protecting and sustaining the environment has always been one of the major goals of TUF since its inception in 2002. UI GreenMetric World University Ranking has ranked TUF among top 500 Universities of the world and ranked 12th out of 55 in local Universities in Pakistan in 2020.



The University of Faisalabad is adhering to the government policy of promoting green technology and ensuring zero carbon footprint by installing a 1.18 MW On Grid Solar panel that fully meets the energy demands of all University campuses. In addition, TUF has also taken the initiative to commercialize the electric bicycle. This has two-fold benefits; firstly, it will encourage fuel-free transportation among the masses. Secondly, it will

bolster the paradigm shift to reining in carbon footprint in the atmosphere by encouraging the adoption of green technology on a large scale. Moreover, it also envisioned that students would embrace this mode of transportation within the campus, thereby limiting the usage of personal bikes. The University has also signed MoU with Forest Department Punjab. In order to save our environment, TUF Environment Protection Club will lay shady, ornamental

and fruit plants at the University in addition to other available spaces of the city throughout the year generally and during tree plantation campaign particularly.

Under the outreach program of TUF, the University will establish Medical Camps in collaboration with Forest Department, for providing check up and medical facilities to the employees of Forest Department, as and when required.
