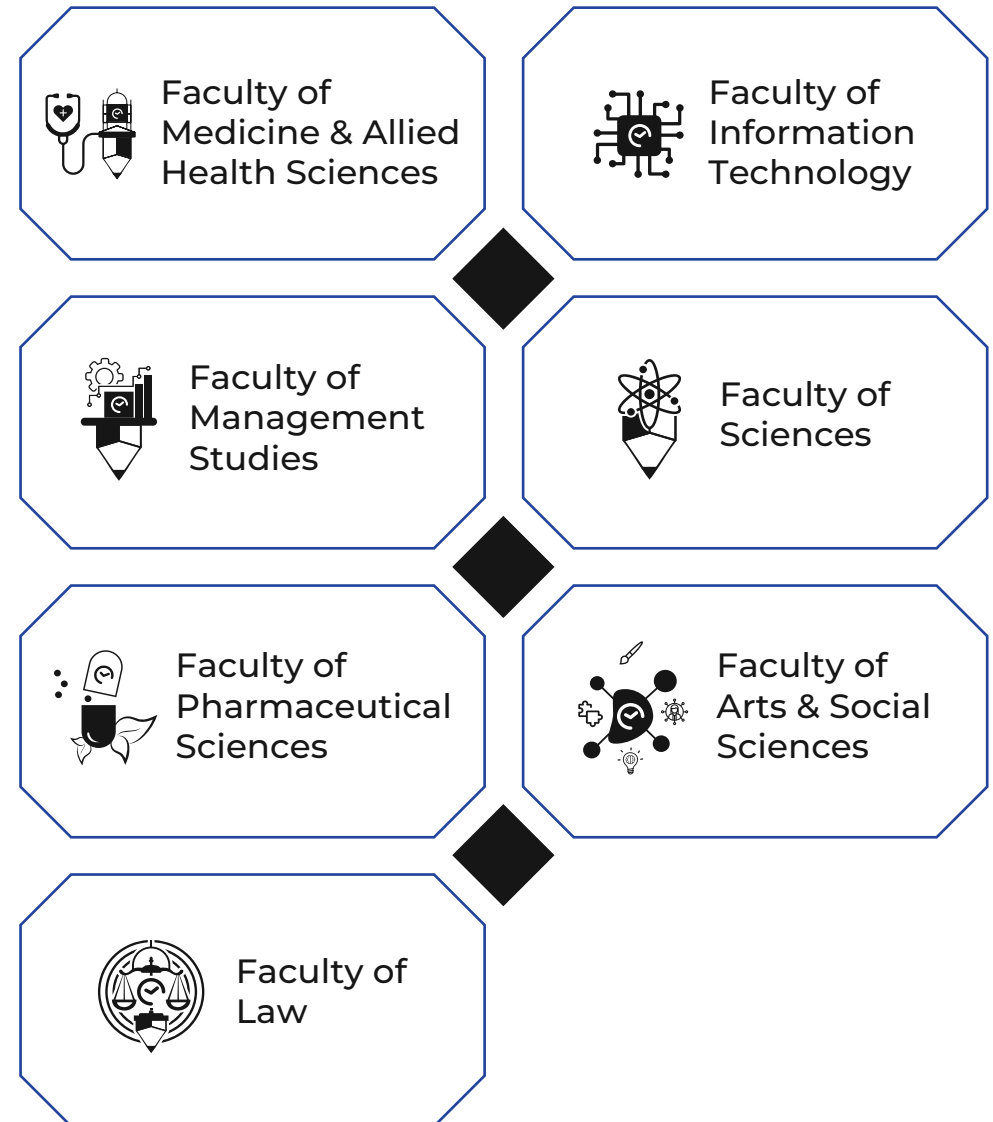

Marked by growing global recognition and a deepening commitment to societal impact, The University of Faisalabad continues to advance as a leading institution of higher education in Pakistan. Established under the auspices of the Madinah Foundation, TUF advances academic excellence, research innovation, and ethical leadership through an inclusive and future-focused learning environment. Supported by its flagship institutions—the University Medical & Dental College and the ISO-certified Madinah Teaching Hospital—TUF integrates quality healthcare education with compassionate clinical practice and community service. The University's growing international profile is reflected in its recognition among the world's leading institutions, including placement in the 401–600 band of the Times Higher Education Impact Rankings 2026 among 2,526 universities globally and securing 4th position nationally for its contributions towards the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. Further reinforcing its reputation for innovation, TUF achieved the 296th global position in the World University Rankings for Innovation (WURI) 2026 and earned Top-100 global placements in several specialized categories, including digital transformation, student engagement, leadership, and empowerment-based management. Its commitment to sustainability was similarly recognized through strong performance in the UI GreenMetric World University Rankings, while the University's research excellence was affirmed by the Higher Education Commission through the award of the highest "X" category to its Office of Research, Innovation, and Commercialization (ORIC), placing TUF among Pakistan's leading institutions for research performance and innovation management.

Intellectual, Literary & Creative

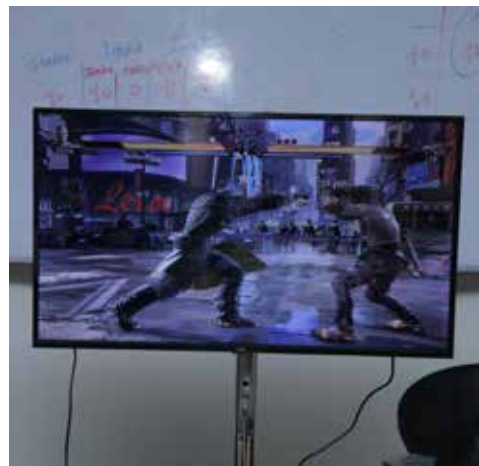

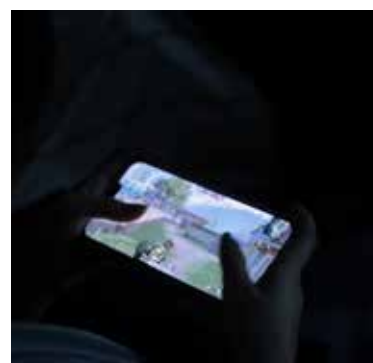
