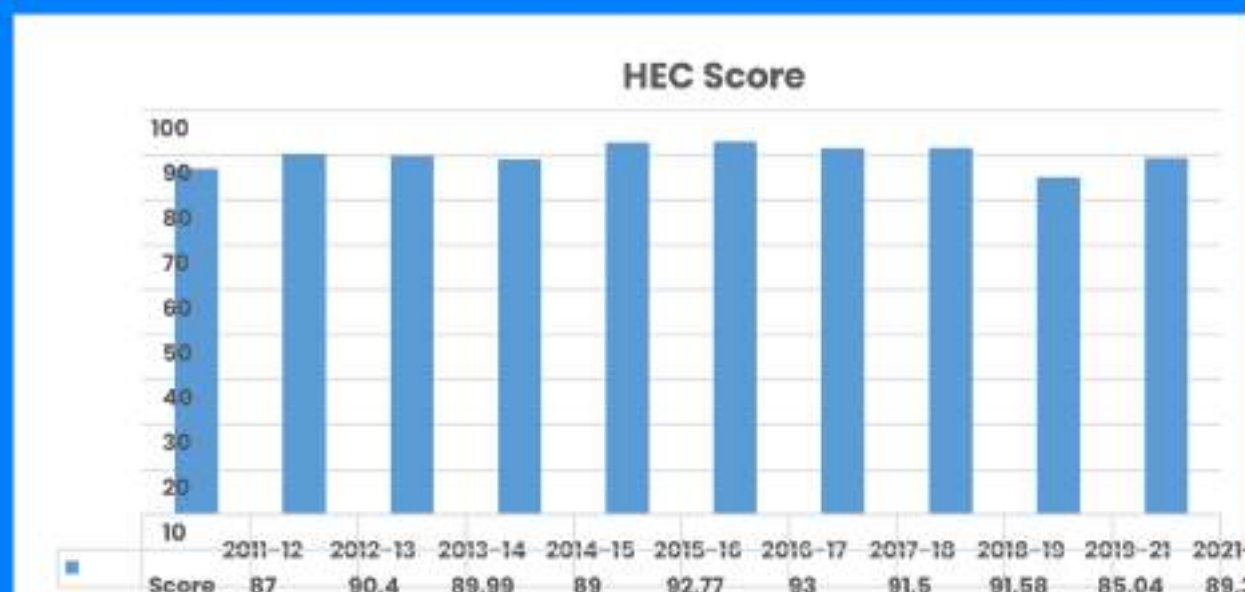

His presentation covered a pictorial comparison of normal and compressed nerves, an insight into proximal nerve swelling, main groups of nerve entrapment, and the axial oblique plane.
