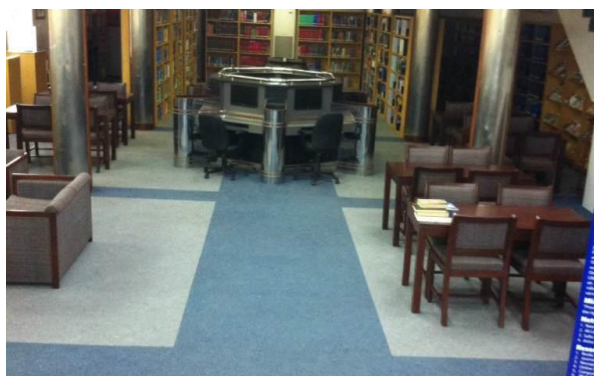

CELEBRATION OF “WORLD SCIENCE DAY”

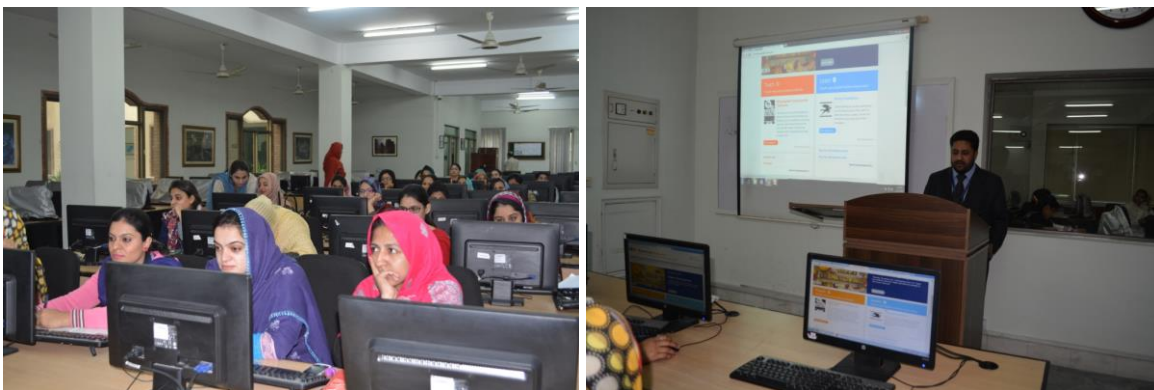

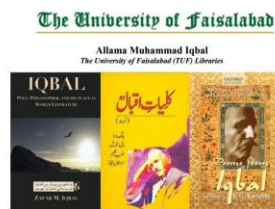
EXHIBITION OF NEW ARRIVALS AND TUF PUBLICATIONS

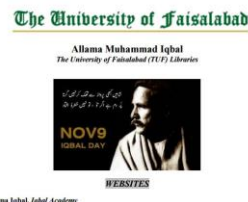


CELEBRATION OF “IQBAL DAY”

ALLAMA IQBAL CYBER LIBRARY

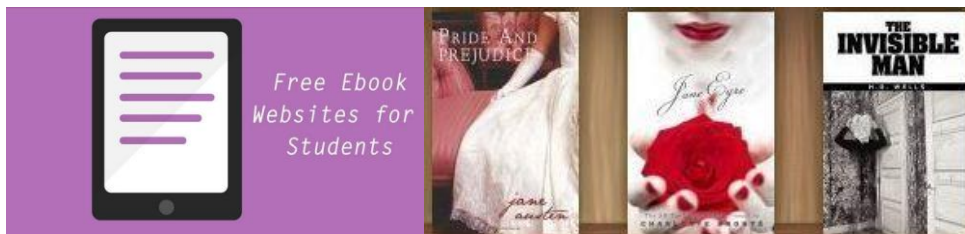

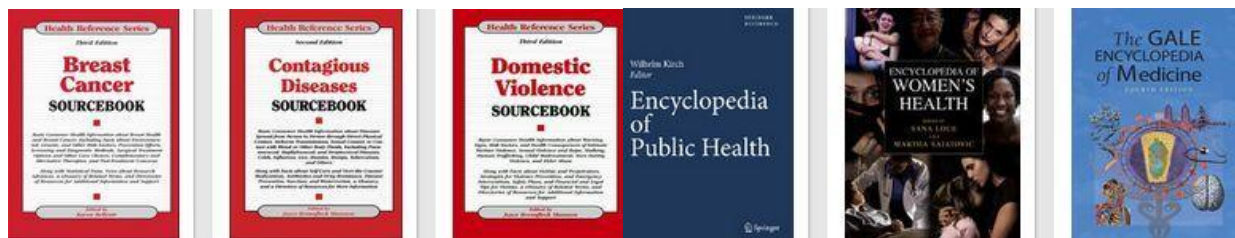
A Website for Teachers and Learners of English as a Foreign Language Abroad

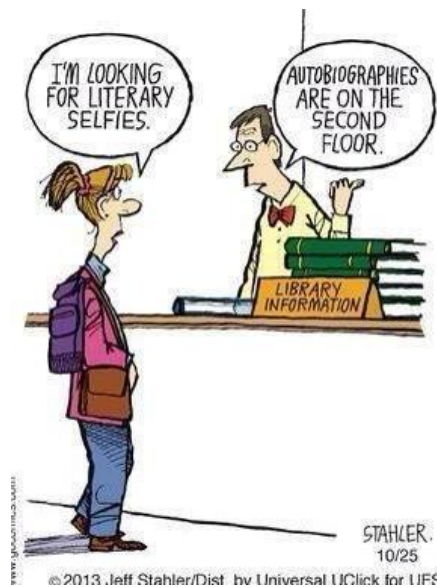


1. **BookFlix**: It includes 115 e-books and 115 video storybooks to help children in learning language, science, history, and literature.

3. **National Geographic Kids**: It is designed for teaching children aged 6-14 and provides articles on science, nature, culture, archaeology, and space.

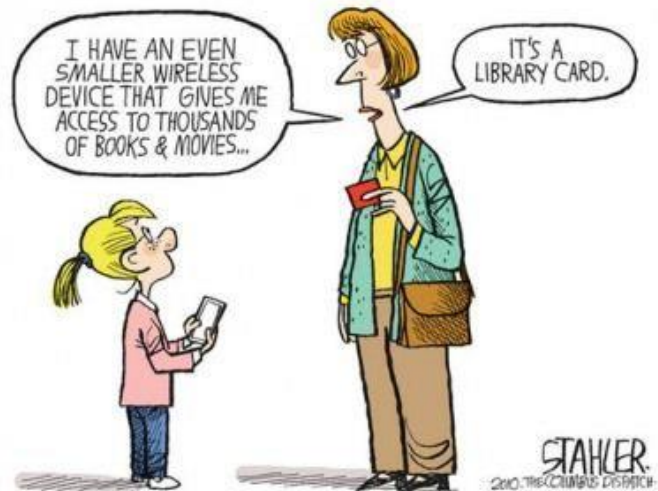
