#### SOUTH ASIAN LIBRARIES CONFERENCE AT LUMS

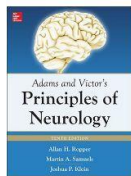

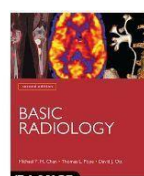
